At end of ramp, move over one lane (right lane is turn only). Follow RT 273W 3.3 miles. You will pass a Wawa on the left before the intersection you need to turn right at. (10th traffic light). Get into right turn lane. Turn right onto Kirkwood Highway and get immediately into the left turning lane. Take next left at light onto E. Cleveland Ave. Stay in left lane. Drive 1.2 miles to intersection with RT 273 Get into right lane (5th light). Turn right onto RT 273 West. (you can follow signs and stay on RT 273 through town, but traffic is often slow through there, easier to bypass it) Follow RT 273 W for 8 miles into Maryland. Middle Rd. will be the next road on the left after you pass Wesley's Restaurant (on left). Turn left onto Middle Rd. Building will be about .8 miles on your left.

premium for that information), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate if the trial-giving club is offering the option of mixed breed entries and provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC) CUP:

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (http://www.akc.org).

Eligibility: These classes are open to **ANY LEVEL** dog registered with AKC. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, **however**, only those dogs running in the 12" & 16" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump height may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. <u>Please note</u>: This year only, for 24" jump height dogs, half of their WTT tryout qualifications is allowed to come from the 20" height. Please see the 2021 AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) for dogs measuring 13 ¾" or less at the withers
- Medium (16" jump height) for dogs measuring more than 13 ¾" but less than16 ¾" at the withers

Large (24" jump height) - for dogs measuring over 16 ⁷/₈" at the withers **Qualifications**: "Clean run" scores from ISC Classes at 12", 16", and 24" (20" for half of the required qualifications for WTT) may be used to fulfill the minimum requirements for WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class.

This Cup is not a Regional World Team Qualifying event. There will NOT be an automatic invite of the combined winners to WTT.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

This trial is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing. A maximum number of entries will be placed on the wait list based on the entry limits as follows:

If trial is one ring/200- 350 runs, maximum will be 25 entries on the waitlist.

If the trial is 2 rings/660 - 700 runs, the maximum will be 50 dogs on the waitlist. If the trial is 3 ring/ 990-1050 runs, the maximum will be 75 runs on the waitlist.

<u>All entries</u>, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by the <u>Wednesday</u> ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend @ 8 am will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry <u>minus a \$5</u> processing fee. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Wednesday @ 8 am ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend will receive a refund.

If there is no waitlist, then there is no refund if you want to pull after the closing date.

If you have not heard about your Wait List status by Friday <u>before</u> the trial weekend, contact us ASAP.

WAH! ISC Cup Event

Event rules:

- To be eligible to win, teams must be entered in all 4 ISC classes.
- A winner will be awarded in each jump height with the overall winner being awarded the "WAH! ISC Cup Winner"
- Scores will be combined for all 4 runs and will be counted as time plus faults.

TRIAL SITE RULES

- If a dog soils on the turf there will be a \$5 "potty fee" that the handler/owner is responsible to pay to the facility. Please be sure to give yourself plenty of time to potty your dogs outside before your run.
- Collars and Leashes All dogs must be on leash at all times when not running in the arena or at the practice jump. <u>This includes the fenced area</u> <u>outside.</u> No flexi-leads allowed in the building or nearby areas such as the parking lot.
- Please NO SMOKING! No smoking is permitted in the building, including bathrooms or within 100 feet of the building. If you must smoke, please do so inside your vehicle and discard all waste safely in an appropriate container. No butts on the ground!
- YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOR DOG & yourself, both inside and out. Please carry the appropriate clean up supplies. All trash goes into the trash cans, potty trash goes into the outdoor cans. All bottles and cans go into the orange top recycle container.
- Please carry the appropriate supplies and keep the trial site clean.
- Dogs may be walked in any area around the arena including fields at the back. Please do not walk near the building while trial is ongoing. Do NOT allow dogs to pee on the building, cars or trash cans. Do not walk dogs beyond the older out buildings close to the fenced dog yard. Clean up after your dog.
- Hotels: Dogs should not be left unattended in the hotel. Reports of barking dogs left unattended in the hotel OR OTHER BEHAVIOR DEEMED INAPPROPRIATE BY THE HOTEL MANAGEMENT MAY be subject to a bench hearing. You must clean up after your dogs at the hotel.
- Garage doors will be open at least part way for ventilation. Doors are on all 4 sides of the building and <u>DO</u> run along both sides of the agility ring. 4' x-pens will be used to block the open doors to prevent dogs from leaving the ring but they can see outside through them while running on course.
- Personal Ez-Ups/tents are allowed to be set up outside.
- Indoor crating is available for people with conflicts but space is very limited. Crating in the care is encouraged and parking is right outside the building.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "*Dogs To Be Measured*" list. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two vears or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurement. If not, and you posses a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures <u>over</u> 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process <u>once</u> after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

What is the jump height card challenge process?

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

<u>RESULTS</u>

Results will be posted on the FAST TIMES website at the conclusion of the trial as well as emailed out to all exhibitors. Be sure to pick up your yellow scoresheet after your run. It will help you keep a record of all of your dog's results.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials only*. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program^{ss}** are eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
